Subject:	AIP ENHANCEMENTS - 2019

Effective Friday, January 17, 2020 National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC) will implement enhancements to the Alternative Investment Product Services ("AIP") into Production. AIP is scheduled to migrate the new Outbound Production Schedule and field level coding on Thursday, January 16, 2020 after the 7:00pm (ET) End of Day Processing Cycle.

Below is a comprehensive description of these enhancements. In addition, we have provided a link to the Data Dictionary 16.2 that identifies the impacted records, fields and values as part of this release. The updated Data Dictionary 16.2 will be posted to the AIP website on or about Wednesday, October 23, 2019.

AIP Enhancement Summary (Mainframe, Web and Portal Users)

1. New Additional Production Output Processing Cycle Enhancement

- o Two (2) new AIP Outbound Cycles will be added to the AIP Service in Production to assist with completing AIP client's daily processing on a timely basis
- Add new 11:10AM & 2:10PM (ET) Cycles in Production

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2. Removal of the Settlement Files in PSE & Production Enhancement

- Currently, the Settlement records are triggered in each of the AIP Output Production Cycles. To eliminate generating files that will not be reviewed during the day, the settlement files will only be triggered twice per day in cycles 01 and 98 – EOD
- o To be consistent, this change will be made in <u>both</u> PSE and Production and the Settlement files will only be sent at the following times (ET):

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Production – Cycle 01 - 6:10AM
Production – Cycle 98 - 7:00PM – EOD Cycle
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PSE – Cycle 01 - 9:00AM PSE – Cycle 98 - 7:00PM – EOD Cycle

3. Security General Profile Enhancements

• The Security Issue ID field will become updatable. This will allow the funds to change their existing ID without having to create a new NSCC Security Issue Number.

4. Electronic Manifest Enhancements - DAY 2

Impacted Records

• 777 – Electronic Manifest

If the E-Doc Manifest is 'rejected' by NSCC, the entire zip file will <u>not</u> be sent back to the submitter. Only the E-doc Manifest will be returned and include the NSCC Reject Code informing the submitter why the manifest was rejected. Once received, the submitter will be able to re-submit the updated E-Doc Manifest with the zip file back to NSCC for processing.

5. Electronic Documentation Record Enhancements - DAY 2

A Version Number field will be added to the Electronic Documentation record that will be transmitted by the Fund. This enhancement will allow the Fund and Firm to be in sync on what version of the E-Doc Manifest is being acted upon. Currently, the version number is only displayed on the E-doc Manifest that is transmitted by the Firm.

- o Add new field name, values, descriptions, condition, validation rule and reject codes
 - Add New Field Name: Version Number
 - Add New Field length: 2 bytes
 - Add New Condition: Required
 - Add Values: 01 99
 - Add New Type: N Numeric
 - Add New Reject Codes 0609 Version Number missing/invalid
 - Field will be added replacing an existing Filler field beginning in position 72
